Does anyone remember house music? Seriously though, house music in its true form exists only in select spots now, and those spots are certain DJ sets that choose to keep that rhythm and vibe alive. Take *Enjoy House* for instance, a three DJ set consisting of 18 tracks that flow with a true 'house' vibe. DJ Dan-O begins his smooth set of five tracks consisting of Basco, DJ Supreme, X-Press 2, Hysteria Ego and the Belgian *wunderkind* CJ Bolland's "Sugar is Sweeter". Dan-O's skillful manipulation of the knobs leads us to Pässean, whose 4 song set of Todd Terry's "Keep on Jumpin", Boris Dlugosh, EWF and Shuffle Inc.'s "Remember" adds melodic cohesion between Dan-O's and G-Spot's grand finale set.

G-spot gigs in Hawaii and Chicago on a regular basis, and if his portion of this mix disc is any indication of his live talent, then the DJ world is at his taking. Beginning with Family's "Submarine", G-spot dances this listener through the Chemical Brothers, Hardfloor, and Opus III, while adding a somewhat more obscurely pleasant flavor with Push to Flush, Skoul Phunk and one of his own tracks entitled "Can G-Spot Come Out 2 Play". His style of beat matching with Way Out West's "The Gift" and Armand Van Helden's "The Funk Phenomena" are skillful and something to watch out for. This mix disc is as professional as it gets without being on a major record label. Its good to see that the indie electronic/DJ scene is thriving with skilled and creative musicians at the helm. -Brad
