As a DJ, PB Wolf brought his hip-hop sounds to Europe, Japan, Australia, Canada and across the United States. In 1996, he founded Stones Throw Records.

Also appearing at the Juicy closing party will be local spinners IKON, Taharba, K-Smooth, Freeze, Stealth, G-Spot, Sonik, Daniel J, Mike D, Scotty Soul, MC Wild Wes, Killowatz Mongoose, Billy G and Lava.
